
CLERY CRIME STATISTICS FOR OTHER CAMPUSES AND STUDY ABROAD SATELLITE CAMPUSES FOR 2018, 2017, AND 2016

In addition to crime statistics collected by the main Athens campus, each of the University's separate campuses located in Griffin, Tifton, and Gwinnett County, Georgia collect their own crime statistics in accordance with the requirements of the Clery Act. In addition, the University's three permanent study abroad locations provide crime statistics as well. These crime statistics are collected from administrators responsible for each of these locations. Please note that the University sold its permanent study abroad campus in Costa Rica in March 2019, and the effect of this divestiture on the reporting of Clery Crime Statistics will be reflected in next year's annual security report.

UGA Griffin Campus:

The following incidents were reported in 2018 by the City of Griffin Police Department: three arrests for drug violations on public property, one incident of burglary.

The following incidents were reported in 2017 by the City of Griffin Police Department as having occurred in the Griffin Campus' Public Property: one incident of sexual battery/fondling; two incidents of aggravated assault; and one incident of motor vehicle theft.
